

TELEKURS ID: TIPS AND TRICKS FOR PROFESSIONAL USERS

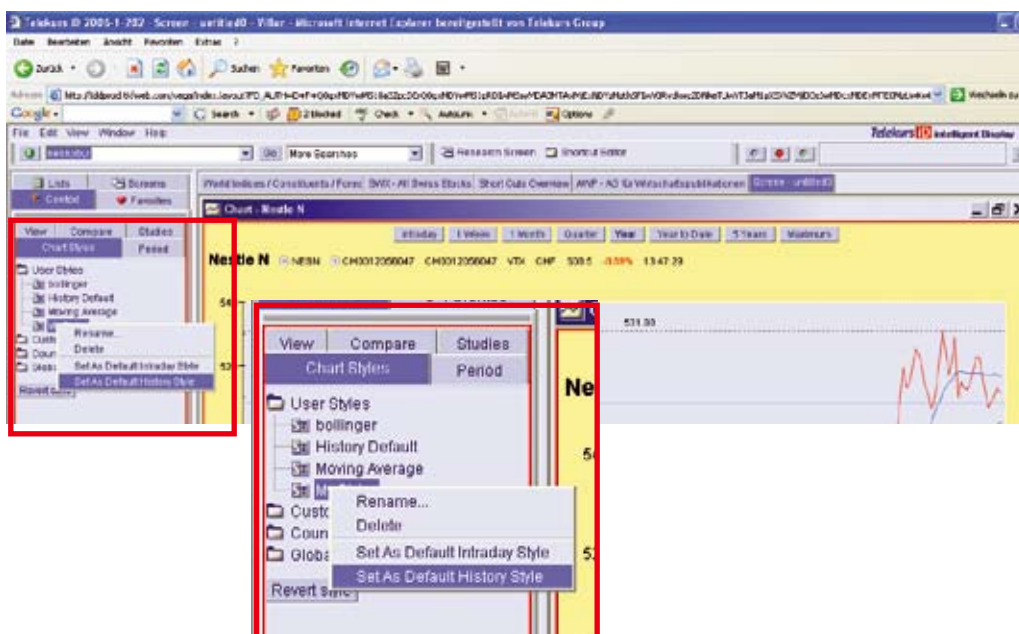

Charts illustrating prices, indices or currencies are a vital tool for technical analyses. Telekurs **id** users normally see a default image when they open a chart, i.e. a graph showing the performance of a financial instrument over a period of one year. Professional users can go one step further!

You may already be familiar with practical shortcuts such as NESN,VTX,C (“C” for Chart). However, not all users know that it is relatively easy to modify the default setting. Here is a practical example:

You want to define price developments and the *moving average 10 – 50 – 200 days* as the default setting. The process is simple:

1. Access the chart via the shortcut (see above).
2. Go to the context menu in the left-hand sidebar and select the corresponding price indicators in the “Studies” tab, e.g. “Moving average 1” for 10 days, “Moving average 2” for 50 days and “Moving average 3” for 200 days.
3. In the top line of the menu select “Save style as ...” and enter an appropriate name, e.g. “My style”, in the relevant entry field.
4. Return to the context menu in the left-hand sidebar and click on the “My style” folder with your right mouse button. Next, highlight the option “Set as default history style” in the context menu.



If you close the chart window and then access another chart (e.g. ABBN,VTX,C), the style you have specified will appear.

Important: this does not apply to charts in the Telekurs Financial screens.
